The flagship wine of Kenzo Estate.

Named for the Japanese Gentian or Bell Flower. A delicate creature, only blooming during the months of July and August, with a dark lavender color. A singular expression of the estate, Rindo comprises an alluring mosaic of Bordeaux varietals from the many vineyard blocks across the property.

Color	Purple fading to an elegant ruby
Bouquet	Rich plum and cassis followed by baking spices and espresso
Palate	Red and black fruits step forward and pronounce as dark chocolate, as tobacco leaf and cedar spice follow with ripe firm tannins
