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A proud wine, representing nobility and elegance

The red wine murasaki, blended only from barrels selected from pure grapes from Kenzo Estate, is a masterpiece where the exquisite individuality of five varieties creates a splendid harmony. While giving off an intense black fruit aroma, it has deep, structured flavor, and creates an elegant atmosphere. Like the obsession with purple that Utamaro pursued through his ukiyo-e prints, murasaki is a rare work, noble and sincere.
