The flagship wine of Kenzo Estate.

Named for the Japanese Gentian or Bell Flower. A delicate creature, only blooming during the months of July and August, with a dark lavender color. A singular expression of the estate, Rindo comprises an alluring mosaic of Bordeaux varietals from the many vineyard blocks across the property.

Color	Bright ruby leading to a deep purple
Bouquet	Dark currant, blackberry and plum surrounded by baking spices
Palate	Red and black fruits meld and open to a lightly roasted mocha, followed by cinnamon, clove and allspice wrapped around velvety tannins
