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A proud wine, representing nobility and elegance

The red wine murasaki, blended only barrels selected from the shining lots from Kenzo Estate, is a masterpiece where the exquisite individuality of four varieties creates a splendid harmony. While giving off an intense black fruit aroma, it has deep, structured flavor, and creates an elegant atmosphere. Like the obsession with purple that Utamaro pursued through his ukiyo-e prints, murasaki is a rare work, noble and sincere.

Palate	Bing cherry mingles with wood smoke, nutmeg and dried berries while chewy tannins integrate with a brisk, mouth coating acidity
