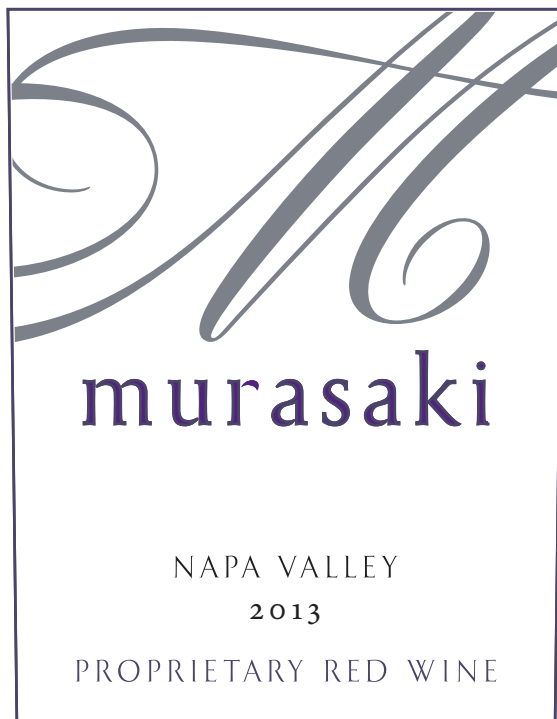

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*The 2013 **murasaki** is once again the ambassador of this estate's alluring minerality. Dark tones of black cherry and blackberry rest atop a layer of crushed limestone. The first sip reveals a stunning tannin underpinning, attributable to the Merlot that delineates this blend, followed by notes of rich confectioner's sugar. A familiar acidity prevails, lending structure to that velvet tannin landscape. Enjoy the 2013 **murasaki** now, in its youth, or in 10 years, in its prime.*
